

## Anzac Day 2017 at Underbool

About 70 locals gathered to march along Monash Ave to the gates of Outen Park while a steady drum beat was sounded by Rosemary.

Frances Lynch led the service at the gates of Outen Park, Maggie gave a reading from 'At the Going Down of the Sun', Kristen presented an account commemorating a century since 'The Charge of Beersheba' (this battle commenced October 31, 1917 and was part of the wider offensive now called 'Third Battle of Gaza', it's final push is now known as 'The Charge of the 4<sup>th</sup> Light Horse Brigade').

Wreaths and remembrances were laid at the memorial gates to the park.

The poignant strains of 'The Last Post and Reveille', played by Ziyoun, allowed a time of quiet reflection and remembrance.

Following the service, a warm 'cuppa' with an Anzac biscuit served in the Underbool Linga Hall was appreciated by participants.
